## WHO CAN LODGE A POSTAL VOTE?

If you are entitled to vote at a Tasmanian election, you may vote by postal vote if you:

- **expect to be unable to attend a polling place on polling day;**  
or
- **are a silent elector** whose address is not shown on the roll. [section 36(5)]

## WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

### The TEC will:

- 1 Process your application
- 2 Mail your postal ballot pack to you

The pack is made up of:  
ballot paper + instructions + special return envelopes

### You will need to:

- 3 Complete your vote before 6pm on polling day
- 4 Send your vote back in the envelopes provided
