Update Monday 6 May; declaration of the polls

Parliamentary elections were held last Saturday 4 May for the Legislative Council divisions of Montgomery, Nelson and Pembroke.

Following are updates of further counting today (Monday 6 May). New results tables are on the following 2 pages.

In **Nelson**, further counting has confirmed that Jim Wilkinson has been returned as the Member. Outstanding votes cannot affect the result of the election and updated figures are attached. The poll will be declared on the steps of the Legislative Council at 10:00 am on Wednesday 8 May.

In **Pembroke**, further counting has confirmed that Vanessa Goodwin has been returned as the Member. Outstanding votes cannot affect the result of the election and updated figures are attached. The poll will be declared on the steps of the Legislative Council at 10:00 am on Wednesday 8 May.

In **Montgomery**, there was no further counting today, as Leonie Hiscutt's election had been confirmed yesterday evening. The poll will be declared at the Burnie City Council Atrium, 80 Wilson St, Burnie, at 10:00 am on Wednesday 8 May.

Final counts for each division will be released next Tuesday 14 May, the deadline for return of postal votes.
