

## If you can't vote on Saturday – cast a pre-poll vote

Electors who can't make it to a polling place on Saturday can still vote early by casting a pre-poll vote before 6pm on Friday at the following southern locations—

Hobart	Australian Electoral Commission, second floor, NAB House, 86 Collins Street
Kingston	Kingston Library, 11 Hutchins Street
Rosny	Rosny Library, Bligh Street

Pre-poll voting is also available at the following northern locations—

Launceston	Australian Electoral Commission, ground floor, 87 George Street
Burnie	Australian Electoral Commission, first floor, Harris Building, 51 Cattley Street
Ulverstone	Ulverstone Library, 15 King Edward Street (open until 5.30pm Friday)

Electors interstate can call 13 23 26 anywhere in Australia to find their nearest divisional office.

### Overseas electors

Electors currently overseas don't have to miss out on having their say. Simply go to the TEC website and follow the links to request an online overseas express vote. Electors have until 5pm Friday 3 May (Tasmanian time) to apply.

### Polling Day

On Saturday, polling places are open between 8am and 6pm.

Polling place details are available on the TEC website and will be published in the Advocate and the Mercury on Saturday. For further information, electors can call 13 23 26 or go to [www.tec.tas.gov.au](http://www.tec.tas.gov.au)

Voting is compulsory for these elections and electors who fail to vote without a valid reason will be required to pay a penalty of \$26.
