

MEDIA RELEASE — 2013 LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Final polling night results

Parliamentary elections were held today, Saturday 4 May, for the Legislative Council divisions of Montgomery, Nelson and Pembroke.

Final polling night figures are shown on the following 3 pages. All figures are provisional and will be rechecked tomorrow morning (Sunday 5 May). In the following commentary, percentages relate to the total formal votes counted so far.

In **Montgomery**, Leonie Hiscutt (45.57%) has a clear lead on Cheryl Fuller (30.15%), Kevin Morgan (14.53%) and Ed Vincent (9.75%). Although it appears that a distribution of preferences will be required, it seems probable that Ms Hiscutt will be elected as the new Member for Montgomery.

In **Nelson** Jim Wilkinson (48.80%) leads Tom Baxter (25.33%), Helen Richardson (17.65%) and Hans Willink (8.22%), and although a distribution of preferences will probably be required, Mr Wilkinson appears certain to have been returned as the Member.

In **Pembroke** Vanessa Goodwin (51.23%) leads Allison Ritchie (35.93%) and Wendy Heatley (12.84%). At this stage it seems probable that no distribution of preferences will be needed and Ms Goodwin appears certain to have been returned as the Member.
