- The enrolment period closed at 5pm on Monday 26 September 2005 and the Preliminary Roll for the election has now been prepared.
- Any person may lodge an objection to the inclusion of the name of a person on the Preliminary Roll **on the basis that the person is not an Aboriginal person.**
- The objection should be in writing and must be received by the Electoral Commissioner by 5 pm Thursday 27 October 2005.
