**Note:** To apply to register a political party, a minimum of 100 members of the party are required to support the application.

Each member supporting the application must be enrolled on the Tasmanian electoral roll, complete a statutory declaration confirming both their membership of the party and their support of the application to register that party and have completed their statutory declaration no more than 12 months before lodging an application with the TEC.

The *Electoral Act 2004* requires information provided on this form to be published in a notice in the *Government Gazette*, and in *The Advocate*, *The Examiner* and *The Mercury* newspapers.
