

Publishing funding claims

Electoral Disclosure and Funding Act 2023

This guideline is issued under section 173(1) of the *Electoral Disclosure and Funding Act 2023*, which allows the Tasmanian Electoral Commission to issue guidelines for any matters dealt with in the Act.

Guideline

Where a claim for payment is made from the Election Campaigns Fund or the Administration Fund, the claimant is required to submit information that includes:

- Contact phone number and email address
- Campaign or personal bank account information
- Signature/s, and
- Copies of invoices, receipts or logbook entries.

Sections 145 and 155 of the *Electoral Disclosure and Funding Act 2023* require the Tasmanian Electoral Commission to publish a copy of each claim to the Election Campaigns Fund or the Administration Fund to its website. The Commission will not publish any of the above-listed information to its website, redacting the information from claim forms as necessary.

This applies to all claims to the Election Campaigns Fund or the Administration Fund made in accordance with the following parts of the *Electoral Disclosure and Funding Act 2023*:

- Part 11 – Public Funding of Assembly Election Campaigns
- Part 12 – Administrative Funding for Assembly
