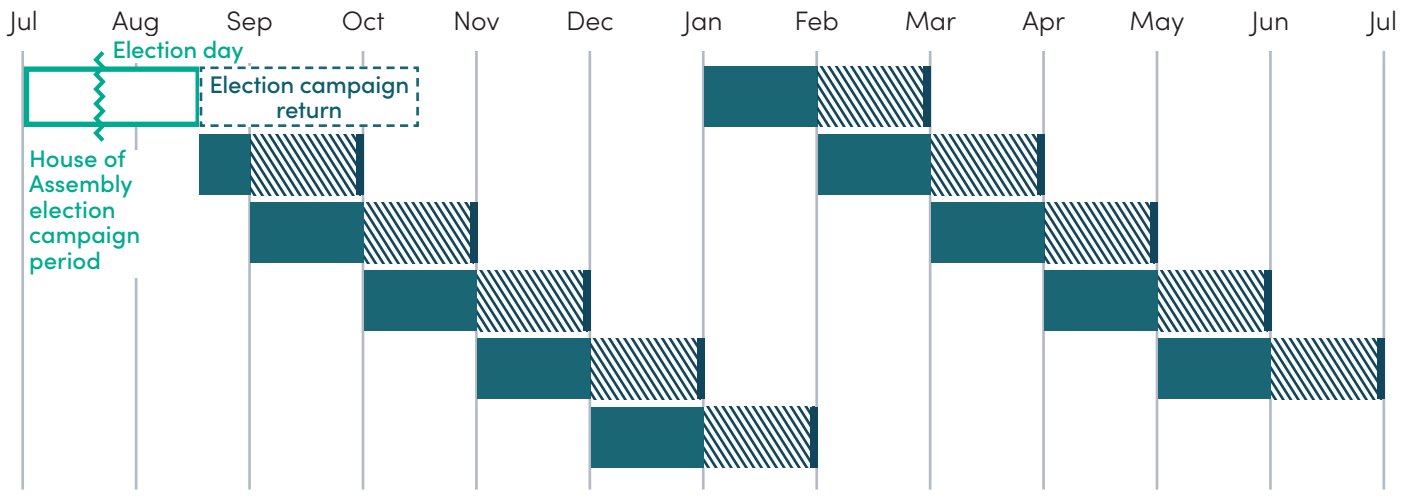


House of Assembly disclosure reporting periods and due dates calendar

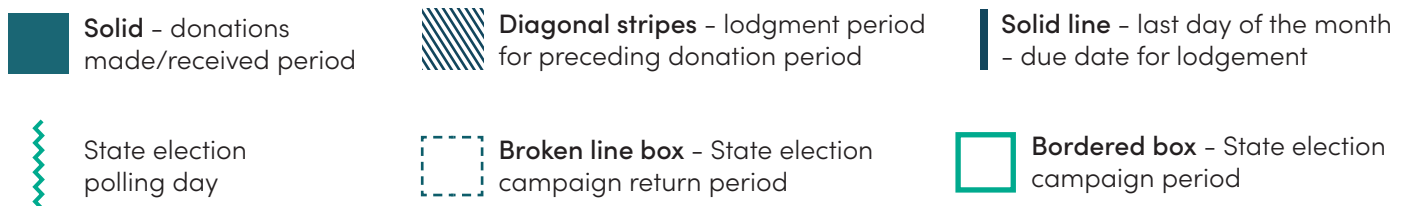

Key information and dates

Disclosure dates

- ▶ **Donation period** - from first to last day of each calendar month (e.g. 1 October 2025 to 31 October 2025)
- ▶ **Lodgment period** - from first day of following month until due date
- ▶ **Due date for disclosure** - last day of following month (e.g. 30 November 2025)

Election campaign period

During this period, disclosure **must be made within 7 days** of a reportable political donation being made or received.

From **1 Jul 2025**, the *Electoral Disclosure and Funding Act 2023* takes effect. The election campaign period for disclosure purposes will run **from 1 July and end 30 days after polling day**.

Election campaign returns

- ▶ Registered parties, House of Assembly members and candidates, associated entities and third-party campaigners (who incur \$5,000 or more of electoral expenditure) must lodge an election campaign return by **17 October 2025** (60 days after the end of the election campaign period).
- ▶ Additional disclosures are required by House of Assembly candidates and members, registered parties and associated entities. Visit tec.tas.gov.au and navigate to the 'Election campaign returns – House of Assembly elections' page to learn more.
