Postal Vote Declaration Envelope

- After you've voted, put your ballot paper into this envelope and seal it.
- Sign the declaration flap on the other side and leave it attached.
- Put this envelope into the Reply Paid Envelope and post it straight away.

To ensure the secrecy of your vote...

The declaration flap showing personal details and signature will be removed by an election official before the envelope is opened.

Envelopes are then opened in random batches and ballot papers removed.
