

Approved Procedure

Required by the *Electoral Act 2004*, section 127(1)

Approved by the Tasmanian Electoral Commission on 1 April 2005

For the purposes of section 127(1) of the *Electoral Act 2004*, the Tasmanian Electoral Commission approve, subject to agreement by the Australian Electoral Commission, the following arrangement to obtain details of electors registered under the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918*—

Arrangement between Tasmanian Electoral Commission and Australian Electoral Commission with regard to General Postal Voters

The Australian Electoral Commission agrees to provide the Tasmanian Electoral Commission with a list of electors registered under the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918* as General Postal Voters.

The list may be used by the Tasmanian Electoral Commission only for the purpose of issuing postal votes to electors in accordance with section 127 of the *Electoral Act 2004*.

The list is not to include any persons who have indicated they do not want their names provided to the Tasmanian Electoral Commission for this purpose.
