

**Approved Procedure**

Required by the *Electoral Act 2004*, section 138(3)

Approved by the Tasmanian Electoral Commission on 5 May 2005

For the purposes of section 138(3) of the *Electoral Act 2004*, the Tasmanian Electoral Commission approve the following manner of recording:

***Manner of recording whether each declaration vote envelope is admitted to further scrutiny or not***

A declaration vote envelope admitted for further scrutiny is to be recorded by a mark beside the name of the elector on the relevant certified list allocated to either absent voting (section 115) or other declaration voting (sections 116 or 117). Envelopes which have been annotated as not admitted, are to be retained for the period required under the Act.
