Required by the *Electoral Act 2004*, section 139(2)

Approved by the Tasmanian Electoral Commission 14 December 2022

Under section 139 of the *Electoral Act 2004*, the Tasmanian Electoral Commission approved the manner of recording whether each postal vote declaration envelope is admitted to further scrutiny to be either —

- by placing a clearly visible mark beside the name of that elector, in the place provided for the purpose on a printed certified copy of an election roll; or
- by providing an electronic mark against the elector's name on a electronic certified copy of an election roll used for managing the postal vote service.

Envelopes that have been annotated as not admitted, are to be retained for the period required under the Act.
