Extract of section 41 of the *Electoral Act 2004*

Permitted use of rolls

41. (1) A person provided with a roll under section 40(2), (3) or (5) is permitted to use that roll only for the following purposes:
- (a) any purpose connected with an election or referendum;
 - (b) monitoring the accuracy of information on the roll;
 - (c) the performance by a Member of his or her functions as a Member.
