

Approved Procedure

Required by the *Electoral Act 2004*, section 40(6)

Approved by the Tasmanian Electoral Commission on a case-by-case basis

Under section 40(6) of the *Electoral Act 2004*, the Commission may provide to any other person, body or organisation, as it may approve, a copy of the State roll or any part of that roll in printed or electronic form.

The clause notes in relation to clause 40 state that for example, "such approval could be given for ethically approved medical research, police, public safety and for other purposes considered to be for the benefit of the individual or the community as a whole."

Organisations currently approved to receive roll information under section 40(6) of the *Electoral Act 2004*

Organisation	Permitted purpose	Data provided
Menzies Institute for Medical Research	Enabling research regarding study participants from Tasmania in studies requiring long-term follow up that requires tracing and ensuring the participant is living in Tasmania.	Name, sex, date of birth and enrolled address.
Monetary Penalties Enforcement Service	Collecting monetary penalties owing from fines and infringements for law enforcement purposes.	Full name, enrolled address, postal address, sex, date of birth, phone number and email.
State Revenue Office	Facilitating the efficient and effective collection of State revenue and the proper administration of grants by the Commissioner of State Revenue and State Revenue Office.	Name, enrolled address, postal address, date of birth and registered overseas electors.
Supreme Court of Tasmania	Ensuring appropriate numbers of people attend statewide Court sittings for jury service.	Unique elector reference number, email and mobile phone numbers. (Under section 19 of the <i>Juries Act 2003</i> the Sheriff is also entitled to name, address and date of birth information.)
Tasmania Police	Law enforcement and intelligence management purposes.	Full name, residential address and date of birth.
Tasmanian Health Service – BreastScreen Tasmania	Recruiting participants in the target age group to send an invitation to participate in the BreastScreen Tasmania program.	For all females 50-74 years of age: Elector ID, title, full name, sex, date of birth, residential address and postal address if different.
Tasmanian Health Service – Patient Travel	Determining eligibility of patients accessing patient travel.	Name, gender, enrolled address and date of birth.
