Notice of intention to cancel registration of the *[name of party]* (less than 100 members)

The Tasmanian Electoral Commission hereby gives notice that:

- The party register has been amended in accordance with section 58(7) of the *Electoral Act 2004* and as a result there are now less than 100 registered members of the *[name of party]*.
- To prevent the cancellation of the registration of the party, the registered officer of the party may, prior to the *[insert date being 30 days from the date of the notice]* lodge an application to add the names of further electors to the list of registered members under section 54 of the Act.
- If, by *[insert above date]* there are not at least 100 registered members of the party, the Commission will, in accordance with section 60 of the Act, cancel the registration of the *[name of party]* and delete all particulars in relation to the *[name of party]* from the party register.
