

Close of roll figures

Voting on Saturday 7 May 2016 will be compulsory for nearly 50 000 Tasmanian electors enrolled for the Legislative Council divisions of Apsley and Elwick.

The numbers of electors enrolled at the close of rolls (6 pm Monday 4 April) were as follows—

Apsley	23 334
Elwick	25 580
Total	48 914

Periodic elections for these divisions were last held in 2010.

Nominations close tomorrow

The period to nominate for these elections will close at 12 noon tomorrow (Thursday 14 April 2016).

The returning officer for each division will announce the accepted nominations at 12 noon Friday 15 April 2016 and conduct a draw for the order of the first rotation of names on the ballot papers. These announcements will take place at—

After Anzac day, the TEC will personally mail an election brochure to everyone required to vote at these elections. The brochure will include a list of the candidates, a map of the division and polling place details. It will also include information on how to vote early for electors unable to get to a polling place on polling day.
