Redistribution of Legislative Council Electoral Boundaries

The main purpose of this submission is to request that the current name of the electorate of Paterson revert to the previous long standing and well accepted name of Launceston. It also supports any submission or submissions which may be made to re-name Wellington to Hobart.

For 148 years (1851-1999) the electorate having similar boundaries to those of the electorate of Paterson had been known as Launceston. Regrettably, in 1999 this important, appropriate name and tradition was changed to a name which in my submission was then, and is still, inapt.

The 1998-99 Legislative Council Electoral Boundaries Tribunal ("hereinafter referred to as "The 1999 Tribunal") which approved of the name change to Paterson said it was being named after Paterson Street in Launceston. Paterson Street is neither a well known geographical feature in Tasmania nor a street which is well known outside the Launceston area. It is not even the main street of Launceston and most of it is within the boundaries of the electorate of Rosevears - not Paterson !

This is inconsistent with the following guidelines enunciated in the "Initial Redistribution Proposal - Reasons" document produced by the 1998/99 Redistribution Committee on Page 12:

"Where new names were proposed, names of well recognised geographical features closely associated with proposed divisions were used. In some cases proposed names also carry an accepted historical reference to proposed divisions".

Paterson Street is not a "well recognised geographical" feature. None of these criteria apply here and none justify the use of the name Paterson in this context. As it is named after a street it carries no accepted historical reference to this division.

The names of Legislative Council electoral districts should readily identify with the area they embrace. The name Paterson does not serve to identify a particular area and it gives little or no indication of where the electorate is or where the boundaries of the electorate are located.

It is difficult to disassociate the name Paterson from the former Lieutenant Governor William Paterson after whom Paterson Street is no doubt named. In this respect it is a matter of significance that the Lieutenant Governor chose not to live in Launceston. It is therefore incompatible for this electorate to be named after a street which was named after him.

These facts are all in contrast to the former name of Launceston which clearly indicated the location of the bulk of the electorate and the fact that significant numbers of Launcestonians live there.

As the Member for Paterson since it was so named I have used that name as sparingly as possible because it gives me no pleasure to be seen to be a representative of an electorate named after a street which is named after a person who declined to live in the area which I am privileged to represent.

I was always extremely proud to be known as the Member for Launceston from 1982 until the regrettable name changer in 1999.

My electorate is likely to have the distinction of being the only electoral division in Australia - probably in the world - which is named after a street. This is a distinction which I am sure people in this area would readily relinquish.

I therefore respectfully request the Tribunal to change the name of the electorate from Paterson back to Launceston.

I submit that there are many convincing reasons for reinstating the name Launceston to the electorate now named Paterson.

There is no other City or major town within the electoral boundaries of Paterson which could in any way compete with Launceston for the naming of this electorate. Hadspen is the only town within the electoral boundaries and I have no doubt the people of Hadspen would in no way wish to have the electorate named after their town in preference to Launceston.

The majority of the electors in this electorate live within the municipal boundaries of the City of Launceston. This was the case as at 30th September 2007 and is projected to continue to be the case on 30th September 2012. The following statistics evidence this.

The electorate contains the Launceston Commercial Business District and all suburbs directly to the south of it, together with suburbs in the Meander Valley Municipal area which are considered to form part of the Greater Launceston area, including Prospect Vale and Blackstone Heights and parts of Prospect. Electors in those areas would all consider themselves to be residents of Launceston.

In addition the electorate contains Traveller's Rest and Hadspen which are generally considered to be dormitory suburbs of Launceston.

The Launceston CBD is the main commercial focus of the residents within these boundaries and the City's facilities are used commonly by electors in all of these areas whether they are within the Launceston Municipal boundaries or not.

The proposed redistributed boundaries will exclude electors currently within the boundaries of Paterson who reside in the Northern Midlands Municipal area. This has the effect, as the Redistribution Committee described in the 2007-08 Initial Redistribution Proposal - Reasons are Page 12 of "*consolidating Paterson as a metropolitan division centred on Launceston's CBD and southern suburbs*". This greater emphasis and concentration on the metropolitan nature of Paterson now places the electorate in a different category from the one considered by the 1999 Redistribution Tribunal. Most of the rural component of the electorate has been removed, making it even more appropriate for the electorate to be known again as Launceston.

Launceston and Hobart are the only two Cities in Australia of comparable size (apart from Alice Springs) which do not have at least one electoral division named after them. This is not only disrespectful but constitutes a slight on these two Cities. They do not deserve this and it is significant that Hobart is Australia's second oldest City and Launceston the third oldest. I submit that they each deserve the recognition that having at least one electoral division named after them is highly desirable and appropriate. The only foreseeable opportunity for this to happen is at the time of this current redistribution of Legislative Council electoral boundaries.

I am attaching copies of the following documents.

These documents are evidence of the extent to which capital cities and major regional cities have electoral divisions named after them.

The examples of cities with more than one electoral division containing their name include the following:

- ***Ballarat*** (Vic), House of Representatives. In Victoria in the Legislative Council and in the Legislative Assembly "Ballarat East" and "Ballarat West".
- ***Bendigo***, House of Representatives. In Victoria Legislative Assembly "Bendigo East" and "Bendigo West".
- ***Geelong*** in Victoria Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly.
- ***Brisbane***, House of Representatives. In the Legislative Assembly "Brisbane Central" and "South Brisbane".
- ***Toowoomba*** - in the Queensland Legislative Assembly "Toowoomba South" and "Toowoomba North".
- ***Melbourne***, House of Representatives. In the Victorian Legislative Council "Melbourne", "Melbourne West" and "Melbourne Port". In the Victorian Legislative Assembly "Melbourne".
- ***Adelaide*** - in the House of Representatives "Adelaide" and "Port Adelaide". In the South Australian House of Assembly "Adelaide" and "Port Adelaide".
- ***Newcastle*** - House of Representatives and in the NSW Legislative Assembly/Legislative Council "Newcastle".
- ***Kalgoorlie*** - House of Representatives and in the Legislative Assembly, Western Australia.

I submit with respect that Hobart and Launceston should not be the odd cities left out and neglected in terms of not having any electoral division named after them, which is the current situation.

Reinstating the name Launceston would be consistent with the extensive use of the name Launceston, within the boundaries of the division of Paterson. The following are some examples:

These examples demonstrate that the whole style and character of this electoral division is "Launceston".


The name Launceston has its stamp impressed widely in and over the area, to the extent that the most logical and appropriate name for this division is Launceston.
