How does the counting process for dual by-elections work?

When a mayor resigns from council, these vacancies are filled by dual by-elections: one for the mayor and one for a councillor.

Nominations are received for the position of mayor.*



Electors vote for mayor



Mayor votes are counted

The candidate who obtains a majority of votes is elected as the new mayor.*



Nominations are received for the position of councillor.



Electors vote for councillor





Councillor votes are counted

The candidate who obtains a majority of votes is elected as the new councillor.





If they are not a current or newly elected councillor, the position of <u>mayor</u> remains vacant. In this case, a new by-election will be required to fill the position of mayor.
